Thanks for your help with Humberto who returns for review following an arthroscopic decompression bursectomy, cuff repair and AC joint excision He should remain in a sling for six week period coming out for elbow wrists and pendulum exercises. And in five weeks from now ie six week following surgery, the sling can be abandoned and then he can start working on some passive assisted active range of motion so that he is getting some reasonable motion by eight weeks following surgery i.e. seven weeks from now. After that he is to continue to working on regaining full range of motion so that at a total of three months following surgery, then strengthening can commence at the three-month, increasing upto the six-month mark so that six months following surgery Humberto has returned back to full duties. I will see Humberto again in six weeks to assess if he is suitable to drive.
