Dear Katrina and Greg

It was lovely to see you both today for a follow up appointment. I was so sorry about your recent miscarriage. This occurred after we had seen a foetal heart in our clinic and on scan around 9 weeks, a missed miscarriage was found. Katrina went on to have a D&C that was uncomplicated and has had no abnormal bleeding since that time. A specimen sent to the lab confirmed normal pregnancy tissue with no rare abnormalities.

We reviewed your recent results and your recent TSH was normal. You are currently taking 225 Thyroxine daily. We discussed that the lower numbers of embryos from your cycles may reflective of either egg or sperm issues. Katrina is already taking DHEA and CoQ10.

We discussed doing some investigations to look for any cause of the miscarriage and I have given a blood test form for you both. We are also going to arrange for Greg to have a SCSA test to check for DNA fragmentation and I will let you know the result of this when it comes through.

You are keen to proceed with a further cycle and I have put a plan in place for this. I recommend we have these results back prior to that time. Your public funding will come up later in the year as well.

I was just reviewing Greg's bloods and he has actually already had a karyotype to check for chromosomes, so you do not need to do this blood test.
