MIITP Plan 2715 09/10/2024: As much as not feeling as bad as previously, has had periods / episodes where that seems to have crept up almost towards that point again. Also feeling very latigued through the day, but just starting to take medications carlier in the evening and regularly at the same time (instead of when remembering / at bed time.) Videohealth with psychiatrist, as well as previous GP Psychiatry Line help, align together, and currently both agree that more time is what's needed to allow SSRI to work optimally. Your continued care is greatly appreciated. MHTP R/V #1 8/1/25: Thank you for seeing Noah Godsell, age 24yrs 9mths, for opinion and management. Your continued care of him and his mental health under PTS SOS R/V NBM 14421 is greatly appreciated. Of note he is still feeling tired and amotivated, however, is seemingly doing better than he was. He still finds staying at the gym hard, but it is easier to get there than previous. He is still tee'd up for admission at ?SJoG on 4/2/25. Given his sertraline is a likely candidate for his tiredness, it's also likely the thing to be doing the most benefit, so we're not changing that in the community as it'll likely be changed in the admission, but we have ceased his mirtazapine (and he will try to reduce dose to a quarter at night for a week before cessation) as it too can cause tiredness / fatigue.

MHTP R/V #2 22/05/2025: K10=26. Have changed medications with an angry day or few with switch-over, but since then hasn't had that as a side-effect. "I don't feel tired." Doing a show this evening, nervously excited. Hopefully continued use brings additional benefit with crasure of previous side effects.
