Diagnoses:

- 1. COVID-19 vaccine induced pericarditis (Brighton level 2) following mRNA-Pfizer vaccines administered on 29/7/21 and 19/8/21
- 2. Right ovarian cyst rupture 2017 diagnostic laparoscopy and appendicectomy.
- 3. LLETZ November 2022.
- 4. Colchicine-induced angioedema (March 2022) .

Medications:

- 1. Anakinra 100 mg daily (commenced 4/1/23)
- 2. Ibuprofen 400 mg tds.
- 3. Pantoprazole 40 mg daily.
- 4. Agomelatine 25 mg nocte.
- 5. Quetiapine 12.5 mg nocte.

I reviewed Lauren Scott in the Covax Clinic today with respect to her pericarditis following mRNA COVID-19 vaccination. She has received anakinra for five weeks and is deriving benefit from therapy with reduced episodes of pain and improved exercise tolerance. She commenced cardiac rehabilitation (Delmar Private) five days ago as kindly organised by Dr Elisa Mulcahy.

I will assess her progress in three weeks.
