Reason for visit:

Pelvic pain

Verbal consent obtained for use of Heidi during consultation.

presenting complaint

- 1. IUD replacement recommended by endometriosis clinic doctor for more frequent replacement every 2-3 years (current IUD 4 years old)
- 2. Worsening pelvic pain different pattern compared to pre-surgery

history of presenting complaint

- 1. IUD replacement: Attended endometriosis clinic, advised anecdotally that people with endometriosis should replace IUD more frequently every 2-3 years rather than standard timeframe. Current Mirena IUD inserted during surgery in 2021, now 4 years old. No breakthrough bleeding currently.
- 2. Pelvic pain: Endometriosis surgery performed 2021. Pain began worsening approximately 1-1.5 years post-surgery. Current pain pattern differs from pre-surgery now experiencing pain on and off without clear pattern, approximately half the days in a 28-day cycle, rated 6/10 severity. Previously pain was cyclical, severe during menstruation and ovulation. No longer able to identify menstrual cycle timing. Associated fatigue for couple of days preceding pain episodes.

Endometriosis - laparoscopic surgery 2021

Vasculitis - diagnosed 2018 at Monash Hospital Dermatology following rash on legs with spreading and leg swelling, non-genetic cause unknown

Azathioprine 150mg tablets, 2 daily (vasculitis)

Pantoprazole 40mg daily

Topiramate 100mg (2 tablets) for migraine prevention, commenced couple of years ago

social history

Not up to date with flu and COVID vaccinations - has voucher for flu vaccine

impression

Endometriosis with worsening pelvic pain post-surgery

Request for IUD replacement

discussion

Pain pattern has changed since surgery - now unpredictable timing rather than cyclical. Pain science education provided regarding individual drivers of pain and lack of correlation between tissue damage and pain severity. Discussed holistic approach to pain management. Patient noted connection between vasculitis activity and endometriosis symptoms.

plan

Trial Slinda (mini pill with ovulation suppression) before considering invasive IUD replacement Mental health care plan review - referral to Anna at Elemental Collective for 5 sessions (pain psychology), face-to-face Collingwood or telehealth available

Questionnaires to complete for additional information for referral

Consider pelvic physiotherapy

Routine health maintenance - cervical screening and STI screening up to date, regular blood tests current due to other health conditions
