The storage of frozen embryos is limited to ten years under the Human Assisted Reproductive Technology (HART) Act 2004, The ten-year expiry date will be calculated from the date of storage of eggs or sperm if frozen eggs or sperm were used to create these embryos. An application to extend storage should be made to the Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ECART) at least 6 months before the 10-year period ends. Please remember to keep in contact with Fertility Associates and to tell us of every change of address so we can keep in touch while you have embryos, eggs or sperm stored.

Publicly funded treatment includes storage of embryos up to 18 months. Storage fees will apply if embryos are stored beyond this time.
