Neoclassical

Element: none

- Initial assessment led to LI-11 L, removed, re-needled - no change; removed, ST-34 left acupressure; some difficulty with responses, clarified instructions (i.e. tight/tender/ticklish at peak of pressure).
- Acupressure: LR-8 right better than LU/PC > Ht tribe
- ST-36 left

Left the room. Provided buzzer.

Reduction in pressure to left SIJ with walking, pressure persists.

D: L4/5 L, SIJ L;

B: standing sacral.

No history of use collagen; future consideration.
